Plant: 16in (40.6cm) diameter; 5in (12.7cm) high; slightly rhizomatous; fast growth rate

Leaf: 5.5in (14.0cm) long; .75in (1.9cm) wide; 3 to 4 vein pairs; greenish yellow heavily rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; lance with tapered base; moderately folded, intensely wavy

Scape: 23 to 26in (58.4 to 66.0cm) high; purple

Scape Bracts: N/A

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; medium lavender, lavender with purple stripes; tubular; Chapel Hill, NC; 7/10 - 7/20 - 8/10

Clump History: the original seedling; 5 years old; Chapel Hill, NC

Notable Characteristics: unique highly ruffled narrow lanceolate leaves with very good substance and unique color, chartreuse becoming yellow or cream
