Plant: 22in (55.9cm) diameter; 14in (35.6cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 7in (17.8cm) long; 4.5in (11.4cm) wide; 6 to 7 vein pairs; yellow margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly wavy and corrugated overall. Rich purple petiole color with white wax extends halfway into each leaf.

Scape: 18 to 20in (45.7 to 50.8cm) high; purple with glaucous bloom

Scape Bracts: N/A

Flower: reddish purple, red at base; tubular; Franklinton, NC; 7/10 - 7/20 - 8/10

Seed:

Clump History: original seedling; 4 years old; Franklinton, NC

Notable Characteristics: Bright yellow leaves with purple filling the base and extending halfway up the leaf.
