Plant: 32in (81.3cm) diameter; 12in (30.5cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 7.5in (19.1cm) long; 5in (12.7cm) wide; 11 vein pairs; intensely blue-green flat margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; ovate with cordate base; deeply folded

Scope: 32 to 34in (81.3 to 86.4cm) high; blue

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.75in (4.4cm) long; pale lavender, darker petal centers; tubular; Chapel Hill, NC; 7/10 - 7/20 - 8/1

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 5 years old; Chapel Hill, NC

Notable Characteristics: F2 cross of a very blue H. sieboldiana x H. longipes with heart shaped leaves.
